

The entire area is thermally active, and the smell of sulphur, a 'rotten eggs' smell that is never far, results in the nicknames 'Sulphur City' and 'Rottenrua'. Milford Sound runs 15 km inland from the Tasman Sea and is surrounded by sheer rock faces, such as the Elephant and Lion Peaks that rise to 1200 m or more on either side. 
