Fri 5 Sep 25 NEW YORK CITY World Trade Centre & Cruise to Statue of Liberty

Today we will travel to the former World Trade Centre, where the tragic events of 9/11 took place. We will meet with a local guide who will take us through the terrible events of that fateful day. Our walking tour starts at St. Paul's Chapel, the oldest public building in NYC still in continuous use. This church miraculously survived the falling building and debris from the 9/11 attacks despite it being only 1 block away. It became a makeshift rescue centre during the aftermath and its iron fence became a bulletin board where family members posted notices of their missing loved ones. Next, hear the heroic stories of the emergency responders at the Firefighter's 9/11 Memorial Wall, and see the Engine and Ladder Company 10/10, the fire station at Ground Zero. Finally, you'll enter the 9/11 Memorial, where you can pay your respects to those who lost their lives in the World Trade Center.

And while no one living today has ever heard the bell ring freely due to its cracked surface, it still resounds with a message of freedom and hope.




